

Trip to Daegu National Museum

Introduction

Featuring the way how to get there and introducing of DNM and so on.

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Welcome everybody to our trip to DNM; here we explain how to get to the DNM. Essentially, this is the program to make your trip nicer and more comfortable. so.. Are you ready? Here we go.

First: Dongdaegu station.(정은영)

Are you ready to go to Daegu National Museum? Where are you now? Have you just got out the flat form and given your train ticket back? If so, look straight ahead. You can see the Exit to go out the right side, two stores would be there. It's time to buy transportation card. If you want to take a subway or a bus, buying this card will be more economical because if you pay as you go you have to pay 1,100 won each bus and whenever you transfer you have to pay again and again but with transportation card, you pay just 950 won which includes transfer fee within an hour. Go one of those stores and take the card which costs 3,000 won, but you have to add additional money for travel. If you want to travel a lot you should charge it with 10,000 won or more. This is a tip. Do you know what you should say when you ask for taking a transportation card? Repeat after me '교통카드 주세요/' don't worry about your pronunciation, usually Koreans

are so kind to foreigners, even if they don't understand what you said. Ok. So, why don't we start our trip with this card? Let's get out from the station. There are many ways to get DNM from here like subway, bus and so on. However I strongly recommend you taking a bus because you have to transfer two times if you take subway. Can you see a bus stop just in front of the station? But actually we are not going. For us, across road, look on right side you can see pedestrian, cross the road and there is a bus stop. As you can see there are many buses no.414, 937,814, but no.414 is the best way, another buses are for transferring by now you might have a question about transportation timetables like your country has. But don't worry we don't have regular schedule and usually buses come every 10 or 15 minutes, you don't have to wait long. Ok. Your bus has arrived, so it's time to use your new card, how to use? It's so much simple, first of all get on the bus and then you can see the machine just next to driver, and touch your card to machine, after this, you can listen 'PIPib 'this sound means that your bus fare is paid. Ok well done so .. now you will pass by 16 bus stops, let me inform you some major stops briefly first Dondaegu station, East express bus terminal, then Daegu MBC next, Manchon station, and Beom-o mokryeon APT and finally Daegu national museum. When you listen the bus broadcasting which is 'the next stop is DNM' ' 다음 정류장은 대구 국립박물관입니다' Push the bell which means you're going to get off. So you gotthere? Nice! Take care see ya~

Second: Daegu station(이정아)

If you are in downtown, you can follow my explanation. There are two ways to get to Daegu National Museum from the Daegu Station. The first way to get there is taking a bus. Frankly speaking, I don't want to recommend this way even though there are lots of bus lines. If you want to take a bus, you have to get on the bus N.420. Wait, Wait. When you take the bus, you should be careful because most korean buses have limited time. In short, as soon as you get on the bus, you should hold a hand strap. It's no joke. After you pass through 19 bus stops, you have to get off the bus at Man Chon Viaduct. I know that you may feel bored or exhausted. Cheer up. There aren't much time left till the destination. Then, you have to transfer another bus from Man Chon Viaduct(만촌육교). At there, you have the 3 right of choices to take another bus. You can take bus, N.349, N.427, N.순환3. After taking next bus, you have to get off after 4 transfer stations. The second way to get there is by subway. This method is more comfortable than the first one. From the Daegu Station, take the subway train in the direction of Daegok. Then, take off at Banwoldang station. Next, transfer subway train for Sawol. After 4 transfer stations, get off the subway at Man Chon station. By your favor, it's not the end. Finally, get off at exit three and take a bus N.349 or 427 or 순환3. Now, you

can find Daegu National Museum.

Third: Airport(정명화)

When you get out of airport, you can see the bus stop. Oh~ better go together. There are buses which have numbers 401, 719, Donggu 2 and Palgong 1. We are going to take a bus number 401, the fare is 1,100won. Regretfully, the fare went up 2 days ago. If you have bus card, actually the fare is 950 won and you don't need to additional charge to go there. But you don't have bus card and have to use two buses, so the sum of your fare is 2,200 won. Oh~ No.401 is coming~. Let's take the bus. oh good. Well, you are going to see the bridge that the name is Konghangkyo and Youngjin College. And then...you are going to see Daegu Bank after the bus turns right, it's time to get off. That place is fifth bus stop from airport. Hey~Hey~ Are you listening to me? What are you doing man~? What are you looking at?? Please concentrate on your attention, now no matter what girl's body is good. Hoo~ I can't bear if you do again. Ok~ time to get off the bus. Now, cross the street in front of the "City Hospital" and take the bus 'Sunhwan 3'. The bus will pass Sinseong elementary school and Keungogae 5 junction. After 15 minutes, pass Keungogae 5 junction, you can see Manchon station. That place might be two-third of your destination. After 10 minutes, you will arrive your destination, Daegu National Museum. Come on; let's go to destination with 'Sun Hwan 3'. For your information, If you want to get there more easily, you use taxi and speak in Korean to taxi driver “대구박물관이요”. But the fare is too expensive. So I think you better use bus. (after a little) Can you see that? That is our destination~.

Fourth: Daegu National Museum(임나영)

Welcome to DNM. Finally you arrived here.

There are a lot of cultural heritages which have distinction in Daegu and Gyeongsangbuk-do Province is exhibited in the DNM. Many relics which were used during the Unified Silla period are displayed here and there, and you can come home to historical feeling in DNM. DNM is composed of three exhibition halls, two planning halls. There are also libraries, a special room where people learn how to make an earthen vessel or rubbed copies. There are promenades and rest places where you can feel cultural things outside the museum. Also, you can enjoy Korean traditional games like

playing yut or stick-hitting game for free.

Usually, it is opened at 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., but it is opened at 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, Sunday and legal holiday. Every Monday and New Year's Day are closed. You have to remember this and not to go there on Monday. If you are in 7 to 18 ages, the entrance fee is just 500 won, and 19 to 64 year old pay 1000 won for entrance fee. In addition, under 6 ages and over 65 are for free.

There is additional information about museum. It is very important to you, so you have to listen carefully. Every fourth Saturday is no charge to enter for everybody, and for teenagers who are less than 18 years old can enter for free on every second Saturday. If you have a plan to go Daegu National Museum, I recommend to you takes a plan on these days. If you need more information about museum before coming, it is very useful that to use DNM Web site. They serve all information about museum in English, Japanese and Chinese. Are you ready to go inside now?
